

What can I use my NDIS funding for?



Here is a simple guide to the sort of services and products your NDIS funding may be used for, for more detailed information please talk to your Support Coordinator.

Funding Type	Funding Category	Examples of services you can access
Core Supports	Assistance with Daily Living	Supported Accommodation Respite In home personal care In home cleaning Maintenance and gardening
	Transport	Funding to assist you with Disability Specific access to supports
	Consumables	Continence products Gloves Low-cost disability specific equipment Tablets or iPads to assist with therapy or access to services
	Assistance Social and Community Participation	Group programs 1 to 1 community access Camps Social Groups
Capacity Building Supports	CB Daily Activity	Therapy services including Occupational Therapy, Speech Pathology, Physiotherapy, Allied Health Assistant and Educational Advisor. Also includes Early Intervention.
	Improved Life Choices	Financial Plan Management - support for an agency to manage your funding and pay invoices for you
	Finding and Keeping a Job	Assistance to link into employment
	Improved Relationships	Psychology Behaviour Practitioners
	Improved Health and Wellbeing	Dietician Exercise Physiologist
	Improved Learning	Transitional Support to move from school to post school options
Capital Supports	Assistive Technology	Higher cost equipment needs that need therapy assessments e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wheelchairs - Hoists - Beds
	Home modifications	Large change to home e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ramps - Bathroom modifications - Vehicle modifications
